SCIENCE ACHIEVEMENTS



- **NCWIT Awards:** FHS had 18 Awardees who were recognized during the CT Affiliate NCWIT award celebration. Awardees included a National Honorable Mention, 8 CT Affiliate Winners, 7 CT Affiliate Honorable Mention Recipients, and 2 CT Rising Star Recipients. We had the most Awardees in Connecticut again (9 of the last 10 years).
- **Science Olympiad:** Team took 5th Place in the State Competition and was the only school in CT to field 3 full teams.

MATHEMATICS ACHIEVEMENTS



- Seventy-five members of the Class of 2023 were inducted into Mu Alpha Theta, a national high school and two-year college **mathematics honor society**.
- Five students were among the top students who participated in the **MAA American Mathematics Competitions** nationwide, and they each qualified for the next level of math competition, the AIME, which is an invitational competition. This is the highest number of FHS students moving on to the invitational competition in recent history.
- Thirty-five students participated in math competitions throughout the year. Our team of students tied for 1st place in the **New England Math Competitions** in our region, which consists of 7 schools. We were also recognized as a high scoring school (cumulative) in the New England Math League, and one student was recognized as a high scoring (cumulative) student.

SOCIAL STUDIES ACHIEVEMENTS



- **Economics Team:** A combined group of sophomore and freshman Econ Team members advanced to the semi-final round of the EuroChallenge, a national competition. Also, eight students competed in the Harvard Pre-Collegiate Economic Challenge this year at Harvard University. The A team finished in the top eight in this international competition and one person from our team scored among the top 2 in the testing portion of the Challenge.
- **Model UN:** FHS Team won Best Delegation awards at the Princeton and World Affairs of Connecticut conferences.
- **Political Action Club:** FHS Team won the Jodi Rell Civility award from University of Hartford.

SAT RESULTS



- During the 2021-22 school year, 97% of FHS seniors took the SAT.
- Math mean: 563
- Evidence-based Reading and Writing mean: 571

AP RESULTS



- 74% of FHS juniors and seniors took one or more AP courses.
- 475 students took 1,094 AP exams in 2022 (in 26 subjects).
- 70% of the FHS AP exam grades were a three or higher
- AP Scholar Awards: AP Scholar (78), AP Scholar with Honor (18), AP Scholar with Distinction (83)

ATHLETIC ACHIEVEMENTS



- Fall 2022 Boys' Soccer Class season record: 8-5-3, qualified for state Class LL tournament
- Girls' Swimming/Diving finished the dual meet season 9-2
- Field Hockey finished 9-4-1-2 (3rd in the CCC North) and qualified for the Class M tournament
- Girls' Volleyball finished 8-11 and qualified for both the CCC and the Class L State tournaments
- Girls Soccer finished 9-4-5 and made it to the second round of the Class LL state tournament. Diana Jedrychowski was named All American.
- Boys' Golf 13-1, CCC Division champions; Division I State tournament 2nd place
- Football finished 3-7, with wins over Avon and Plainville to secure the Olde Canal Cup.
- Boys' and Girls' Cross Country finished 1-6 and 2-7 respectively. Anna Weygang qualified for the State Open
- Boys' and Girls' Crew had a large turnout, 114 athletes, and were highly competitive

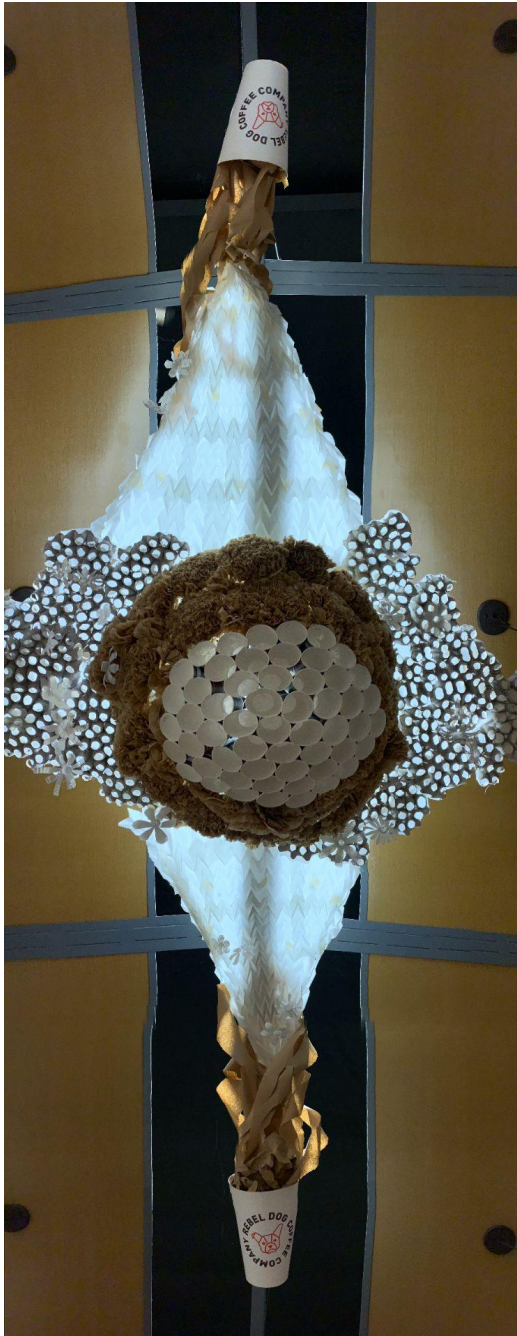

ART ACHIEVEMENTS



Grants:

- The Art Dept. partnered with FCE and the Hillstead Museum to run a ESSER funded (\$160,000) summer art program with 210 participants from Hartford County and 25 FHS Art Mentors
