# Farmington Collaborative Preschool Weekly Activity Report

**Week of:** 12/4-12/8 **Theme:** Traditions **Focus:** Hibernation

This week we started our "Traditions" unit with a focus on Hibernation. Students experienced a variety of educational activities involving different animals that hibernate. Miss Seamour did an interactive whole group lesson with us where we discussed what it means to hibernate and exploring what animals hibernate, which don't, and even what animals migrate to warmer places. We also took a virtual field trip to watch some real life bears interacting with each other.

(Build a home for animals to hibernate in)	Numeracy/Puzzles: Various puzzles, sorting and patterning. (Sorting bears, Mouse color by number, Hibernating match, Help frog get to the log to hibernate)	Get Set For School: Readiness & Writing: Aim and Scribble (Night Sky), 'Where do you start your letters?', Letter L, & Number 1
